Known also as <u>The Communion</u> and <u>The Breaking Of Bread</u> and the <u>Eucharist</u> from the Greek eucharisteo, "giving of thanks".

I. WHAT IS THE MEANING OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

A. IT IS A MEMORIAL ... 1 Cor 11:23-25

- 1. Jesus used the bread and the cup to help us <u>remember</u> Heb 10:20
- 2. We <u>commemorate</u> the death of Jesus on the cross– Heb 9:16, Heb 10:4, Heb 9:22 Eph 1:7

B. IT IS A PROCLAMATION ...

- 1. We proclaim our faith in the efficacy of the Lord's death 1Co 11:26a
- 2. We also proclaim our faith in the Lord's return 1Co 11:26b

C. IT IS A COMMUNION... 1 Cor 10:16-17

- 1. A fellowship or sharing with <u>each other</u>
- 2. A fellowship or sharing with <u>Christ</u> 1 John 1:7, 9 Rev 3:20

A.WITH <u>REVERENCE</u>...

- 1. "in a <u>worthy manner</u>" 1 Cor 11:27,29
- 2. With understanding of the seriousness of this observance

B. WITH THANKSGIVING ...

- 1. With appreciation for the <u>supreme price</u> Jesus paid for our sins
- 2. With appreciation for the <u>love</u> Jesus manifested to us John 15:13, Isaiah 53:10, Heb 12:2
- C. WITH <u>SELF-EXAMINATION</u>... 1 Cor 11:28.
