HOW TO LEAVE A LEGACY AT HOME

Deuteronomy 6:1-9

Deuteronomy 6:1-3 (NLT) These are the commands, decrees, and regulations that the LORD your God commanded me to teach you. You must obey them in the land you are about to enter and occupy, and you and your children and grandchildren must fear the LORD your God as long as you live. If you obey all his decrees and commands, you will enjoy a long life. Listen closely, Israel, and be careful to obey. Then all will go well with you, and you will have many children in the land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, promised you.

Psalm 78:5-6 (Msg) He (God)...commanded our parents to teach it (God's Word) to their children so the next generation would know, and all the generations to come...

1. KNOW THE LORD PERSONALLY.

Deuteronomy 6:4 (NLT) Listen, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD alone.

2. LOVE THE LORD PASSIONATELY.

Deuteronomy 6:5 (NLT) You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength.

3. PURSUE THE LORD CONSISTENTLY.

Deuteronomy 6:6 (TLB) You must think constantly about these commandments I am giving you today.

4. TEACH THE LORD INTENTIONALLY.

Deuteronomy 6:7-9 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.
