- I. The Definition of Crazy Faith
  - Faith is not <u>a blind leap</u> in the dark.
  - Faith is not <u>a feeling</u>.
  - Faith is not <u>reason</u>.
  - Faith is not simply a <u>belief</u>. (James 2:19)
  - Faith is the <u>assurance</u> of things hoped for. (Heb. 11:1)
  - Faith is the <u>conviction</u> of things not seen.
- II. The Craziness of Faith
  - It sees what is not visible. (Heb. 11:27)
  - It <u>rejoices</u> in difficulties. (James 1:2)
  - It gives instead of takes. (Acts 20:35)
  - It serves instead of demands. (Mark 10:42-45)
  - It <u>loves</u> its enemies. (Matthew 5:44)
  - It <u>sacrifices self</u> instead of pampering self. (*Matt. 16:24-25, Heb. 11:35-39*)
- III. Let's Get Crazy
  - It Takes Preparation
    - 1. Start with prayer. (Mark 9:24)
    - 2. Completely <u>surrender</u> everything. (*Heb. 11:25-26*)
  - It Takes Knowledge
    - 1. Diligently seek Him. (Heb. 11:27)
    - 2. Diligently seek <u>His Word</u>. (Heb. 11:17-19, Rom. 10:17)
  - It Takes Experience
    - 1. Check the <u>references</u>. (Heb. 11)
    - 2. Just <u>do it</u>. (Heb. 11:8)
    - 3. Burn your bridges. (Heb. 11:29, 31)
