Job 6:8-10 “Oh, that I might have my request, that God would grant my desire. I wish he would crush me. I wish he would reach out his hand and kill me. ‘At least I can take comfort in this: Despite the pain, I have not denied the words of the Holy One.’”

Job 23:10-12 “But he knows where I am going. And when he tests me, I will come out as pure as gold. For I have stayed on God’s paths; I have followed his ways and not turned aside. I have not departed from his commands, but have treasured his words more than daily food.”

FOUR WAYS JOB OBEYED GOD’S WORD

1. MORALLY - Job stayed pure.

2. VERBALLY - Job guarded his mouth.
Job 27:3-5, Job 31:5-6
3. RELATIONALLY - Job cared for those around him.
Job 31:13-15, Job 31:16-23
4. MATERIALLY - Job saw all that he had as a gift from God.
