Definition of Grace

- Grace is free sovereign favor to the ill-deserving. B.B. Warfield
- In grace, God gives nothing less than Himself. Grace, then, is not a third thing or substance mediating between God and sinners, but is *Jesus Christ in redeeming action*. *Michael Horton*

Manasseh is an extreme example of <u>"ill-deserving"</u>. 2 Chronicles 33:2-7, 9

Six Principles of Grace from the life of Manasseh ("Jesus Christ in redeeming action")

- 1. Grace restrains judgment on us. John 3:17
- 2. Grace <u>pursues</u> us.
 - Through the Word of God. 2 Chronicles 33:10
 - Through circumstances. 2 Chronicles 33:11
- 3. Grace leads us to <u>repentance</u>. 2 Chronicles 33:12, *Romans 2:4*
- 4. Grace forgives us. 2 Chronicles 33:13,23, Romans 5:20
- 5. Grace sets us free. 2 Chronicles 33:13, Romans 5:21, 6:14
- 6. Grace <u>empowers</u> us. 2 Chronicles 33:14-16, 2 Corinthians 12:9, 1 Corinthians 15:10, Hebrews 9:14
